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Electronics

-All that is needed is a laptop running PureData 0.50 or higher and the patch (available from the composer). Pure Data can be downloaded for free at <http://msp.ucsd.edu/software.html> and can run on both PCs and Macs.

-The patch produces stereo output, and the laptop can be plugged into the available audio system with.

-The timing of cues is flexible, and each cue will run until the next cue is triggered (there is no need for a click track or any rhythmic synchronization - all that is needed is for the performer to press the space bar at the moment specified in the score).

NOTES TO PERFORMERS

All trills are to be a 1/2-step unless otherwise noted (the other option is "timbral," notated with a "T" above the trill).

All accidentals hold for the entirety of the measure unless canceled by a different accidental.

Boxed notation indicates that a specified action should take place for the duration of the notated beam. It should sound somewhat random, and not coordinated with the other members of the section performing the action. Players may breathe as necessary (as long as they are staggering with other members of the section).
